

Healthy Harbours Porirua. Permission Form

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

Your child will be taking part in *Healthy Harbours Porirua* this term. The HHP programme will teach your child about life in the local streams, the Porirua harbour and coastal areas. Through the programme they will develop their science skills and take part in field trips to develop their understanding and awareness of the local area. This will also involve learning snorkel skills for the final trip in Term 4, to either Plimmerton/Whitireia Park or Titahi Bay (weather dependant).

The HHP programme coordinators and the School will manage all aspects of the field trips and HHP will provide snorkel equipment, instruction, resources and safety management for all in-water and harbour activities. Your assistance in providing support for field trips is essential for the success of the programme.

Details of Freshwater Field Trip/Harbour Session - Te Onepoto Park (Kahotea Stream)

Aims: To develop water quality testing skills, investigate human impacts on local streams and identify local biodiversity values/ and or investigate human impacts and biodiversity in the harbour.

- 6) Towel and change of clothes (in case they get wet).
- 6) A good pair of shoes for walking and gumboots or old shoes for wearing in the water.
- 8) Warm clothes.
- 9) Pen, pencil, and rubber.

The programme is part funded by the Greater Wellington Regional Council. **A contribution of \$5 is** requested for each student for gear wear/tear and maintenance. This cost also covers the use of student materials, field trips and the final snorkelling session.
