Your child, as one of the Enviro Leaders, has the opportunity to come on a visit to Kapiti Island on the 26th September. We are going to visit to see what an Island Sanctuary is like. We will receive a 30-minute presentation at the Doc centre where we will learn about the natural history of Kapiti Island, ecology of the island stories of the Ngati Toa Rangitira and the story of sustainability. We hope to see rare and endangered birds in their natural environment, birds found nowhere else in the world, and to hear their bird song

It will be an early start. We need to be at Paraparaumu Beach by 8.30. We will meet at school at 7.30 am and make our way up to Paraparaumu Beach by car. Next will be an exciting 20-minute boat ride from Paraparaumu Beach through the Kapiti Marine Sanctuary to Kapiti Island – launch off the beach in our purpose-built boat.

We aim to be back at school by 3.00pm. If anything (traffic etc.) interferes with this, I will contact you directly on the number you put below.

It will be long, active day so a big lunch is a must as is a good sized water bottle.
