### Location:

Snorkelling takes place off the **boat ramps at the north end of Titahi Bay**. The site is accessed by driving down John st, and left into Lambley. Snorkelers will enter the water off the slipways adjacent to the boat sheds. Snorkelers are guided around the rocky reef with instructors from Mountains to Sea Wellington (<http://mountainstoseawellington.org/>) and parent supervisors. There will be a ratio of one adult to every two children.

This location which is home to blue moki, paua, 7 armed starfish and much more. It will be an amazing opportunity for students to deepen their understanding of the marine life in our local area.

### What to bring:

Towel, togs, spare bag for wet clothes, hat and good walking shoes. We advise children to bring their own sunblock if they have sensitive skin and pack extra snacks in addition to a packed lunch. Wetsuits and snorkelling gear are supplied. Your child can wear bring their own wetsuit if they have one.

### Parent supervisors

Changing rooms, toilets and parking is available next to the snorkel site at the end of Vella Street if you are meeting us at the beach. Otherwise please join us at school and walk with the class at 9am (if you are joining the morning group) or 11.30 am (if you are in the afternoon group).

We thank you for your time as we wouldn't be able to offer this experience without your support to ensure safety. If for any reason the trip is cancelled we will let you know before school.
