WHAT'S HAPPENING THIS TERM

Noho Marae

In week 8, 22nd June, we will be having a Noho Marae for our year 6s. They worked on their pepeha in Term 1, and will share these at the noho. We will need parents to help. If you are willing and able please let your child's class teacher know ASAP. We have to police vet anyone staying overnight and this takes time.

Tuarangi

In the first half of this term we will be exploring Tuarangi (Outer Space). This will include an inquiry around Te Marama (The Moon), Te Rā, (The Sun), and Ngā whetū (The Stars). This will be timely as we explore Matariki and celebrate Matariki as a marked National Holiday on the 24th June.

Coding

In the second half of this term we will explore coding. We will look at what coding is - sometimes it's called computer programming. We will create code - sets of instructions - telling a computer what to do in order to create some simple games. We will do a mixture of on screen and on paper coding.

Book Week

Book week is week 4. There will be a daily quiz with a prize for the top scoring class. Dress up day will be Friday 27th May. Book swap day will be Thursday 26th May - children are encouraged to bring in books they no longer want and swap them for different books.

Year 6 Camp

Year 6 Camp is booked for Term 4, week 6, this year from 23rd to 25th November. This will take place at El Rancho in Waikanae. More information will come out about this in the coming weeks and we will ask for parents who are keen to attend camp to register their interest.
