I hope you all had a really fun school holiday with your children and got to sleep in and not have to rush in the mornings doing lunches and getting them to school. I loved having some time and space in my life and it really gears us up for the next 35 school days left for 2020. When we return from Labour weekend we will have only 30 odd days and that is a little scary. Please remember this **FRIDAY 23 OCTOBER** is **Teacher Only day**. No one will be on our school site.

We have a big term ahead and you will have all received the Long Term plan for each HUB and their newsletter for this term, which is full of dates and events that will be happening.

You will see we have collated all these dates for each HUB later in this newsletter for you to pop on your calendar. You can also check these out on our school website under newsletters.

The term has started well and our teachers are busy assessing and writing school reports. The reports come home on Monday 7 December and if you would like an interview with the class teacher you just drop them an email or call in and they can set that up for you.

It is a special time for our year 6 tamariki as they have come to the end of their education at Titahi Bay School and once again they are going to a range of different schools next year and we know they will leave us with KURA values deeply embedded in their daily life.

We had a lot of property work completed at our school over the holidays. The ongoing removal of asbestos is completed in Room 7,8,9,10,11,12 and 13 and under all our walkways around the school. Rooms 7,8,9,10,11,12, and 13 have now all had new ceilings, new insulation, new wiring, new fire systems, wall coverings, new paint, and carpet and they are looking the best I have ever seen in these classes. We also started the refurb of Rooms 1,2 and 3 and you will see that R2 and 3 just need new carpet now and R1 will be completed in the Xmas holidays.

Next holidays we will refurb the toilets by R16 and also the carpet in Rooms 5 and 6.

Our teachers have had to move furniture each holiday break but we know it is worth it.

Our BoT continues to work on getting the basics right at our school with property and ensuring our \$\$\$\$ go a long way.

At the last BoT meeting, they passed to accept the government's program of free lunches for all the tamariki in our school. This will start **Term 2, 2021** and each day we will get lunches delivered to our school, sometimes hot and sometimes cold. This is for every child in our school and when I know more about this I will come back to you.

We have been informed that milk in schools will stop next year but at this stage, we will still have fruit in schools.

Once again our BoT have signed up for the donations covered by the government so this covers our school trips for 2021. The only other cost for next year is school camp and we have and will continue to raise funds for this so that the cost is \$50 per child rather than the \$265 it costs for camp.

We have been contacted by some whānau re adults writing unkind comments on social media about another student. This has happened outside of school time and we have no control over this and so we are telling parents to talk to Netsafe who will do something and this is seen as very important by them. It makes us sad as our KURA kids are taught about the digital world

and what is appropriate and what isn't. So if you have a problem with something someone has written on line, please contact Netsafe as they are very effective and will do something straight away.


